

# Caribbean Stud Poker

To begin, the player must place a bet in the ante circle and then receives five cards face down. The dealer receives four cards face down and one card face up. After looking at the cards, the player has the option of either continuing the game or folding.

If the player wishes to continue, exactly double the amount of the ante must be bet. If he folds, the ante is forfeited. After all players decided, the dealer reveals the remaining four cards.

The dealer only plays with an Ace and King or higher. Should the dealer not have an Ace and a King or higher, the player receives "even money" (1:1 payout) on the ante.

If the dealer's cards beat the player's cards, the dealer collects the ante and the bet. If the player's cards beat the dealer's cards, the player will receive "even money" (1:1 payout) on the ante, and a bonus amount on the bet:

High Card:	1:1	Flush:	5:1
Pair:	1:1	Full House:	7:1
Two Pair:	2:1	Poker:	20:1
Three of a kind:	3:1	Straight Flush:	50:1
Straight:	4:1	Royal Flush:	100:1


## Winning Combinations

- in ascending order -




### High Card

The highest card wins, if there is no other connection



### Pair

Two equal cards.  
The highest valued pair wins.



### Two Pair

Two pairs of equal cards.  
The highest valued pair wins.




### Three of a kind

Three equal cards.  
The highest triplet wins.



### Straight

Five consecutive cards.  
The highest beginning value wins.




### Flush

Five cards of the same color.  
The highest valued card wins.




### Full House

A three of a kind and a pair.  
The highest triplet wins.



### Poker (Four of a Kind)

Four equal cards.  
The highest valued poker wins.



### Straight Flush

A straight with the same color. The highest valued beginning card wins.



### Royal Flush

A series of a 10, Jack, Queen, King and Ace of the same color.
