Zero-Game (with 4 chips) Seven numbers that lie between 12 and 15 on the roulette wheel.



The Rules

The game begins with the words "Faites vos jeaux" ("Your bets please"), by the croupier who will make all the announcements. Place your bets on the "tableau".
